This was the second family that Santa visited. The 2 little ones didn't want anything to do with him.

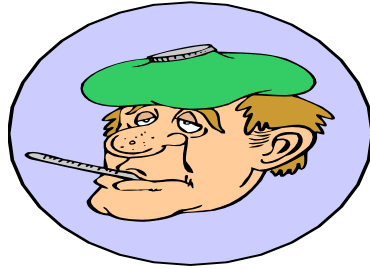


Santa brought lots of gifts and food for the kids. That made this family very happy for Christmas this year.

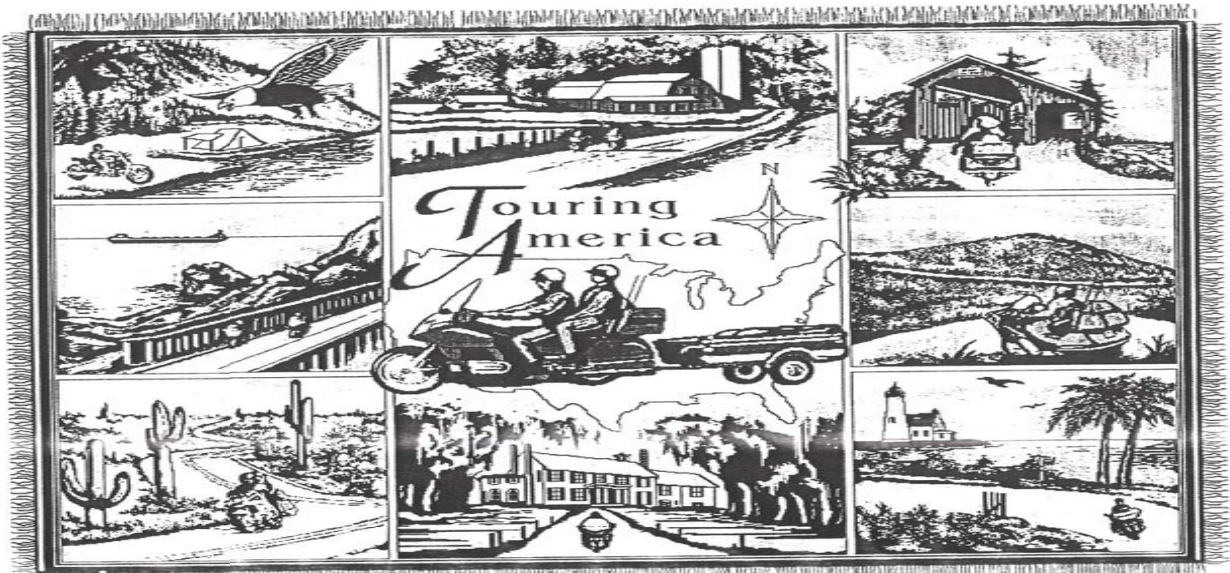

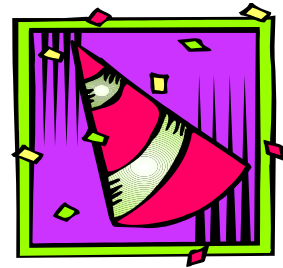

DON'T YOU BELIEVE IT.

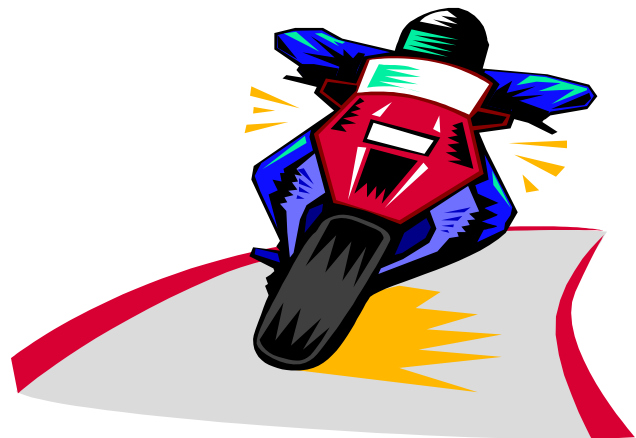
