# Rider Education

GWRRA has a lot of information on their web page relating to education that I encourage all of you to read the information on the web site. There is a tremendous amount of information on their site. Their web page is [www.gwrro.org](http://www.gwrro.org)

It is a proven fact that the more time spent in a parking lot practicing slow riding skills will enhance your riding ability on the road by leaps and bounds. There are a couple of classes that teach these skills. I encourage beginning riders to take the Basic Riders Course (BRC). For the experience rider there is a class for you as well. The class is the Experienced Rider Course (ERC). Most of the local Community Colleges offer these classes during the summer months. Last year, if you were a member of the Honda Rider's Club of America, upon successful completion of HRCA they will refund \$75.00 for taking the class. To my knowledge they still offer this benefit. HRCA also has many other perks such as motel discounts etc. It's worth looking into to see if it is for you.

While Top Gun has been put on the back burner for now ... rider education is heating up. Several of us in our Chapter are working out the details to hold a once a quarter parking lot practice after our Chapter Meeting. Each quarter we will work on several parking lot skills that will come from the Top Gun Format. They may not be identical but will be the same basic skills. The skills will start out very basic and progress to more difficult skills. While I encourage everyone to try the skills it is voluntary and is available to all who attend the meeting. The skills will build on each other and the length of practice times will vary with the skills. We are working toward less than an hour for everyone to get some practice in. In about a year we will have completed the skills you need to compete in the Top Gun Competitions. Who knows, by next year a Chapter "C" ONLY Top Gun Competition may be in our future. We will have our first parking lot practice at our September Meeting.

We will work on three skills.

Straight line slow ride  
Emergency quick stop  
Cone weave

I look forward to everyone riding their bike in September to work on their riding skills.

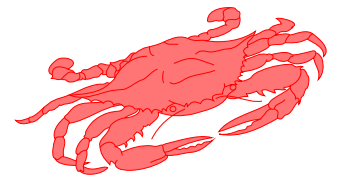

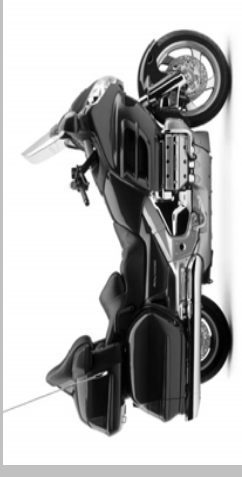
